

Compliance Bulletin Hazardous and Special Products Collection Systems May 29, 2023

This document provides compliance guidance to producers and producer responsibility organizations (PROs) who are required to establish and operate a collection system under the Hazardous and Special Products (HSP) Regulation - O. Reg. 449/21 (the "HSP Regulation").

The intent of the collection system is to ensure that the public can access collection services throughout Ontario to drop HSP materials off at. This requirement is separate from producers' requirements to manage HSP materials collected at a collection site.

While the HSP Regulation requires each producer to establish and operate a collection system, multiple producers are allowed to use the same collection site to set up the collection system. It is not necessary for a producer to have an agreement with every producer or PRO who operates a site that is included in the collection system.

#### 1.0. Categories A and B:

Oil Filters, Oil Containers, Antifreeze, Solvents, Paints and Coatings, Pesticides, and Pressurized Containers (Non-refillable and Refillable)

Beginning January 1, 2023, producers and PROs of categories A and B (<u>excluding</u> refillable pressurized containers) are required to establish and operate a collection system comprised of collection sites for the applicable category that meets each individual producer's requirements, as outlined below. These requirements vary depending on whether a producer is considered a large or small producer under the HSP Regulation.

The requirement to establish and operate a collection system can be achieved by producers and by PROs where a PRO has entered into an agreement with a producer to provide collection services.

Large producers, including large producers of refillable pressurized containers, have an additional requirement to provide call-in collection services, as further explained in section 1.1.4.

#### 1.1. Large Producers of Categories A and B

A producer is considered a large producer of a type of HSP in a given calendar year if the producer's average weight of supply in the previous year (which is calculated as the average supply of the three years before that year) was as follows:

Type of HSP	Large producer's average weight of supply (in tonnes)
Antifreeze	300 or more
Non-refillable pressurized containers	100 or more

Oil Containers	55 or more
Oil filters	100 or more
Paints and coatings	1,000 or more
Pesticides	9 or more
Refillable pressurized containers	100 or more
Solvents	70 or more

## 1.1.1. Collection system requirements for large producers of antifreeze, oil containers, and oil filters

All large producers of antifreeze, oil containers, and oil filters need to ensure a compliant collection system exists by either:

- Establishing and operating a minimum number of collection sites in every municipality and territorial district, where the number of sites required is based on population size, as set out in <u>Schedule A</u>, or
- Establishing and operating a collection system with a minimum number of collection sites in every municipality and territorial district based on retail locations operating in the previous calendar year, where the number of sites required is as follows:
  - In each local municipality with one or more retail locations that supplied the producer's type of HSP to consumers in the previous calendar year, as many HSP collection sites as are equal to or greater than 75% of the number of those retail locations, rounding up to the nearest whole number. For example, if there were 10 retail locations in the municipality, 75% would mean 7.5 collection sites, which rounded up to the nearest whole number means 8 HSP collection sites would be required.
  - If the municipality or territorial district has a population greater or equal to 1,000 and no retail location supplied the producer's type of HSP to consumers in the previous calendar year, then the producer must establish and operate at least one HSP collection site.
  - If a territorial district has one or more retail location that supplied HSP to consumers in the previous calendar year, then the producer must establish and operate at least one collection site within 30 kilometers of each of those retail locations.

## 1.1.2. Collection system requirements for large producers of non-refillable pressurized containers

All large producers of non-refillable pressurized containers are required to ensure a compliant collection system exists by establishing and operating a minimum number of collection sites in every municipality and territorial district, where the number of sites required is based on population size, as set out in <a href="Schedule A">Schedule A</a>.

In addition, large producers must ensure that a depot for the collection of non-refillable pressurized containers is established and operated at a recreational area (e.g., a campground) if requested by a representative or employee of the recreational area.

For such depots, producers must:

- Provide a sufficient number of storage containers to store the spent non-refillable pressurized containers prior to their collection,
- Provide a sufficient number of appropriately labelled collection receptacles for visitors and patrons to drop off the spent non-refillable pressurized containers, and
- Agree to a collection schedule for the depot and collect the non-refillable pressurized containers according to that schedule, or collect the non-refillable pressurized containers from the depot within 21 days of receiving a request from a representative or employee of the recreational area.

# 1.1.3. Collection system requirements for large producers of paints and coatings, pesticides, and solvents

All large producers of paints and coatings, pesticides, and solvents need to ensure a compliant collection system exists by establishing and operating a minimum number of collection sites in every municipality and territorial district, where the number of sites required is based on population size, as set out in <a href="Schedule A">Schedule A</a>.

#### 1.1.4. Call-in collection requirements for all large producers of categories A and B

As noted above, all large producers of categories A and B (<u>including</u> refillable pressurized containers) are required to provide call-in collection services:

- If a large producer is notified by a representative of one of the entities or operations listed below that 100 kilograms or more of a type of HSP within category A or B has been collected, the producer must collect all of that type of HSP from the entity or operation within three months of being notified:
  - A council of the band.
  - A municipality that is not located in the Far North¹.
  - A territorial district that is not located in the Far North.
  - A depot where HSP is collected that is owned or operated by the Crown in right of Ontario and that is not located in the Far North.

If a producer or a PRO is notified by a representative of a council of the band requesting collection on a reserve in the Far North, the producer or PRO must make reasonable efforts to collect the material within one year of being notified.

#### 1.2. Small Producers of Categories A and B

A producer is considered a small producer of a type of HSP in a given calendar year if the producer's average weight of supply in the previous year (which is calculated as the average supply of the three years before that year) was as follows:

Type of HSP	Small producer's average weight of supply (in tonnes)
Antifreeze	Greater than 20 and less than 300
Non-refillable pressurized containers	Greater than 3 and less than 100
Oil Containers	Greater than 2 and less than 55
Oil filters	Greater than 3.5 and less than 100
Paints and coatings	Greater than 10 and less than 1,000
Pesticides	Greater than 1 and less than 9
Refillable pressurized containers	Greater than 8 and less than 100
Solvents	Greater than 3 and less than 70

A producer of a type of HSP in categories A or B is exempt from all obligations except for record keeping (i.e., no requirement to register or establish and operate a collection system) if their average weight of supply in respect of that type of HSP falls below the lower threshold noted in the table above

# 1.2.1. Requirements for small producers of antifreeze, oil containers, oil filters, non-refillable pressurized containers, paints and coatings, pesticides, and solvents

All small producers of antifreeze, oil containers, oil filters, non-refillable pressurized containers, paints and coatings, pesticides, and solvents need to ensure a compliant collection system exists by either:

- Establishing and operating a minimum number of collection sites in every municipality and territorial district, where the number of sites required is based on population size, as set out in <u>Schedule A</u>, or
- In each local municipality or territorial district with one or more retail locations that supplied the producer's type of HSP to consumers in the previous calendar year, establishing and operating as many HSP collection sites as are equal to or greater than 75% of the number of those retail locations, rounding up to the nearest whole number.

#### 1.3. Operation of HSP collection sites

The HSP Regulation sets out requirements for each collection site that must be established and operated.

It is the responsibility of the producers and PROs to ensure the collection sites are in compliance with the collection site requirements.

Producers, or PROs on their behalf, may set up collection locations that do not meet the below requirements, such as collection within a business that is not accessible to the public. While these sites may be used to achieve management requirements, they cannot count towards a producer's collection site requirements (except for producers of oil filters, oil containers and antifreeze).

#### Producers must ensure the following:

- If a collection site for a type of HSP is operated by a municipality or territorial district, the
  site must accept, at a minimum, all types of HSP<sup>2</sup> in the same category. For example, if
  a municipality accepts solvents, which are in category B, it must also accept all other
  materials in category B, including antifreeze, oil containers, paints and coatings,
  pesticides, and refillable pressurized containers.
- Producers of antifreeze, oil containers, and oil filters that are required to establish and operate collection sites in a local municipality with a population of 5,000 or more, and where at least one retail location supplies the producer's product, must ensure that at least 4% of the sites, rounding up to the nearest whole number, are accessible to the public.
- Collection sites for antifreeze, oil containers and oil filters that are open to the public, as well as all other collection sites for other types of HSP, must accept HSP during normal business hours throughout the calendar year.
  - Normal business hours are, for example, a company's regular business hours, (e.g., a retail location opening from 9:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. must accept HSP material from 9:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m.).
  - Throughout the calendar year is considered to be in every part of the year; seasonal sites do not meet the requirement.
- Collection sites must accept up to 25 kg from any person per day of each type of HSP accepted at the site.
- If a site is not a retail location and accepts more than 50 kg of a type of HSP from a person on a single day, the operator of the site must make reasonable efforts to record the person's name and contact information, any identifier assigned by the Registrar, and the weight of the HSP.
- Collection sites must not charge consumers to drop off HSP.
- Collection sites must be serviced in order to operate (i.e., HSP material collected must be hauled to a processor or disposal facility).
  - Producers, or PROs on their behalf, must manage (i.e., process or safely dispose) all material collected at a collection site within three months from the date the material is picked up from the collection site.
  - Note that the requirement to service sites continues even if the collection system produces more HSP material than is required to meet any minimum management requirements.

Note that neither of the following is considered a collection site:

- A depot for the collection of non-refillable pressurized containers at a recreational area (e.g., campgrounds).
- A location of one of the following entities or operations requesting call-in collection services:
  - A council of the band.
  - A municipality that is not located in the Far North.
  - A territorial district that is not located in the Far North.

 A depot where HSP is collected that is owned or operated by the Crown in right of Ontario and that is not located in the Far North.

As of January 1, 2023, seasonal sites are not considered collection sites. If a municipal site does not meet the requirements of a collection site, such municipal site may rely on the call-in collection service to get their material collected. Nevertheless, municipal seasonal collection sites that meet the requirements of a collection event may count as a single collection event.

# 1.4. Reduction in HSP collection sites for producers of antifreeze, oil containers, oil filters, non-refillable pressurized containers, paints and coatings, pesticides, and solvents

Producers of categories A and B may reduce the number of sites required in a local municipality or territorial district for a type of HSP in three different ways:

- By providing curbside collection services to residences,
- By providing curbside pickup following notification to the producer, or
- By providing collection events.

A producer may combine the following three ways of reducing the number of collection sites.

#### 1.4.1. Curbside collection

Producers may reduce the number of collection sites for a type of HSP required in a local municipality or territorial district by the percentage of residences, including multi-unit residential buildings, from which the producer provides curbside collection for that type HSP at least four times per year and where the producer has provided containers at no charge (adequate collection containers must be provided at no charge).

#### 1.4.2. Curbside pick up

Producers may also reduce the number of sites required in a local municipality or territorial district for a type of HSP by 25%, rounding to the nearest whole number, if:

- The producer provides an accessible mechanism (e.g., phone number, online form) for residents of that local municipality or territorial district to notify the producer that they have a total volume of 10 to 50 litres or a total weight of 10 to 50 kilograms of that type of HSP and,
- The producer then provides curbside pick up to any residences, including multi-unit residential buildings, for that type of HSP once the producer has received such notification.

#### 1.4.3. Collection events

The number of HSP collection sites required in a local municipality or territorial district for a type

of HSP in a calendar year may be reduced by the number of HSP collection events the producer provides for that type of HSP in the local municipality or territorial district in the calendar year.

Producers can reduce the number of collection sites through collection events up to a maximum of 25%, rounding up to the nearest whole number, of the total number HSP collection sites required across Ontario (prior to any reductions resulting from curbside collection or curbside pickup following notification).

Collection events must satisfy all of the following requirements:

- The collection event must be readily accessible to the public.
- If the collection event is for antifreeze, oil containers, or oil filters, the event must accept all three of these materials.
- The collection event must operate for a minimum of four consecutive hours.
- If the collection event operates consecutively for more than one day, it must be considered a single collection event.

Producers or PROs must contact RPRA to review the details of any of the collection site reduction initiatives outlined in sections <u>1.4.1</u>, <u>1.4.2</u> or <u>1.4.3</u> to confirm it will decrease their collection site requirements.

Municipal seasonal collection sites that meet the requirements of a collection event may count as a single collection event.

#### 1.4.4. Reductions of oil filters, oil containers and antifreeze

Producers of oil filters, oil containers and antifreeze that are required to ensure that 4% of the required collection sites in each municipality are accessible to the public may apply reductions. However, the 4% of sites should be calculated after the reductions are applied. Please refer to the example below:

Required number of collection sites in a given municipality	100
Number of required collection sites that are accessible to the public	4% of 100 = 4
Collection events during the year	25
New number of required collection sites	100 - 25 = 75
New number of required collection sites that are accessible to the public	4% of 75 = 3

As demonstrated in the above table, collection events help reduce the number of collection sites required but do not directly replace collection sites that must be accessible to the public for these materials.

#### 1.5. Alternative locations of HSP collection sites

Where a producer is required to establish and operate collection sites in a local municipality that is a lower-tier municipality forming part of an upper-tier municipality, the producer may choose to establish and operate those sites in alternative locations within the upper-tier municipality (e.g., in another lower-tier municipality within the upper-tier municipality that is outside of the specific lower-tier municipality) up to the following limits:

- For oil filters, oil containers, antifreeze, solvents, pesticides, and pressurized containers (non-refillable and refillable), a producer can establish and operate up to 5%, rounded up to the nearest whole number, of the collection sites required for that type of HSP in alternative locations.
- For paints and coatings, a producer can establish and operate up to 17%, rounded up to the nearest whole number, of the collection sites required in alternate locations.

#### 1.6. Minimum of one HSP collection site or event

Regardless of whether a producer, or a PRO on their behalf, implements one or more of the above reduction initiatives or alternative locations, they must establish at least one collection site or collection event for a type of HSP in each municipality or territorial district in a calendar year if there is a retail location in that local municipality or territorial district, that supplies the producer's type of HSP.

For clarity, if a municipality or territorial district doesn't have a requirement to establish a collection site or event for a particular material based on population requirements, the presence of a retail location in that municipality that supplies the material will not create a need to establish a collection site.

## 2.0. Categories C and E: Mercury-containing Devices and Refillable Propane Containers

Producers and PROs of a type of HSP in categories C and E are required to establish and operate a call-in collection service for that type of HSP.

If a producer or a PRO of a type of HSP in category C or E is notified by a representative of one of the following entities or operations that that type of HSP needs to be collected, the producer or PRO must collect all of that type of HSP within three months of being notified, regardless of the tonnage the entity or operation has collected:

- 1. A council of the band.
- 2. A municipality that is not located in the Far North.
- 3. A territorial district that is not located in the Far North.
- 4. A depot where HSP is collected that is owned or operated by the Crown in right of Ontario and that is not located in the Far North.

If a producer or a PRO is notified by a representative of a council of the band requesting a collection on a reserve in the Far North, the producer or PRO must make reasonable efforts to collect the material within one year of being notified.

# 3.0. Category D: Fertilizers

Producers of fertilizers are <u>not</u> currently required to establish and operate a collection system.

### 4.0. HSP collection system reporting of categories A, B, C, and D

On or before July 31 in each calendar year, HSP producers, either directly or through a PRO, are required to report the following information regarding collection and management systems to the Authority (as appliable) as part of the annual report:

- The name, address, email, phone number, including a primary contact person for each site and material type that is part of a collection system.
  - Reporting of this information by a producer or PRO also indicates that this
    producer or PRO will ensure these collection system sites are in compliance.
- A list of any curbside collection services, collection upon request, collection events and call-in collection services.
- The name and contact information of each hauler, processor and disposal facility that processed or disposed of that type of HSP.

A separate report must be submitted through RPRA's Registry for each type of HSP.
