

Add Facility for EGR-Spill

This work instruction document covers how to add an Emergency Generator Registration (EGR) facility in the HWP Registry for when a spill has occurred.



Work Instruction (STEP-BY-STEP)

Work Instruction conventions:

- All field, page, section, tab, and button names appear in **bold** font.
- All fields are **required** to be completed unless indicated otherwise.





4. Complete the following <u>required</u> fields:

Field	Description
Facility Name	Enter a descriptive name that clearly identifies this as an EGR spill site. Note: This field is limited to 80 characters.
Waste Generation Activity	Select Emergency Generator Registration (EGR). Note: When this option is selected, the EGR Number field is displayed. This number should be provided to you by the Spills Action Centre.
EGR Number	Enter the EGR number provided to you by the Spills Action Centre





Note: Review the information note that some fields are optional during the initial creation of the EGR facility but must be completed within ninety (90) days of creating the facility.

5. In the **Facility Location** section, complete the following <u>required</u> fields unless otherwise indicated as optional:



It is important to provide the most accurate description and address of the spill site since not all spills occur at a site location, but could occur elsewhere, for example, on side of the road.

Field	Description
"This is a Canadian	Checkbox indicates the facility address is Canadian.
Address	Note: If this box is <u>not</u> checked, the fields presented on the form vary slightly for collecting a United States address.
Street	Street address of the facility. Note: Start typing a street address to be prompted with matching address options; select the address from the pop-up list.





Postal Code	Postal code for the facility location.
Latitude and Longitude (optional)	These two fields default from the Google address database that matches to the address entered above.
Description <i>(optional)</i>	Optional short text that describes your facility location.

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6. In the **Facility Mailing Address** section, complete the following <u>required</u> fields:

Note: As a shortcut, click either the **Copy Business Address** or **Copy Facility Location** option to copy in the respective address if the mailing address is the same.

Field	Description
Street	Start typing a street address to be prompted with matching address options; select the address from the pop-up list
City	City where facility is located
Province	Ontario defaults if Canadian address checkbox is selected, but can be changed if necessary
Postal Code	Enter the postal code for the facility Note: The postal code must be entered in all uppercase to be recognised by the system; otherwise, the entry will not be accepted.
The following fields are only shown when the checkbox "This is a Canadian Address" is <u>not selected</u> . In this section, the checkbox defaults as selected (☑).	
State	Select the appropriate US state where the facility is located
Zip Code	Enter the US zip code where the facility is located
Country	United States defaults but can be changed if necessary





7. In the **Primary Hazardous Waste Program Contact** section, complete the following required fields unless otherwise indicated as optional:

Note: If you are the primary contact, select the I am the primary Hazardous Waste

Program contact as a shortcut to have the fields populated with your contact information.




