




Add Facility for EGR-Spill


This work instruction document covers how to add an Emergency Generator Registration (EGR) facility in the HWP Registry for when a spill has occurred.

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Add Facility for EGR Spill

Roles:	Account Admin, Primary User, Secondary Users, Manifest-Only Users, and Drivers of Generators and Authorized Generator Delegate (AGDs)
1.	<p>From the Hazardous Waste Registry Homepage, select Facilities tab.</p> 
2.	<p>Select Add Facility.</p>  <p><i>The Retrieve Facility Information window displays.</i></p>

3. Select the option: **No, create a new facility.**

Postal Code	Postal code for the facility location.
Latitude and Longitude (optional)	These two fields default from the Google address database that matches to the address entered above.
